

Four in a row

Each player has a different colour of counter.
Players take alternate turns.
On each turn they roll two dice with ten sides showing 0 to 9 .
A player can choose to use either the sum of the two dice or the difference, and puts a counter on a square with that number.
There can be as many counters on a square as there are players.
The winner is the first player with 4 counters in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line, as shown below.


The adult can be handicapped by only being allowed to use addition.
