fun + skills $=$ confidence
This game helps the child learn their three times table.

Each player has a different colour of counter.
Players take alternate turns.
On each turn they roll a die with ten sides showing 0 to 9 .
They then multiply the number by 3 and put a counter of their colour on a square with that number.
(You cannot put a counter on a square where there is already a counter.)

The winner is the first player with 3 counters in a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal line.
You can use the same game for other times tables by making your own grid using the spreadsheet "Grid for three in a row ANY times table".
